Register at the door for \$30. There are no late fees this year.

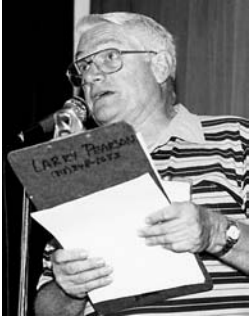

## CAL-STEWART 2008

The Cal-Stewart brochures were mailed out to all of you in early September and all of you should have received yours two months ago. If you need more copies, go to the Cal-Stewart website, [www.cal-stewart.org](http://www.cal-stewart.org) and follow the instructions and you can view and print out a copy.

By the time you read this, it will be much too late to mail in your registration, so fill out both sides of the registration form and bring it to the on-site Registration desk on the **upper level** of the Brown Hall (Conference Center). Try to have the exact change (\$30) or a check made out to TTOS-SW in the amount of \$30, and this will speed up the registration process for everyone doing on-site registration. If you want to renew your Southwestern dues, please make out a **separate** check payable to TTOS-SW for \$25. Renewal forms will be available at Registration. If you want to renew or have a problem with your National TTOS dues, National will staff a table on the lower level of the Brown Hall to take care of you.

The Brochure was carefully worded to explain how the meet will work this year. Still, there is confusion, and this report will attempt to explain in new words what we are doing this year. The location continues to be on the east side of the property while work gets completed on the new Exhibit Hall on the west side of the property (where we used to be prior to 2007). The new Exhibit Hall will be completed in time for Cal-Stewart 2009. We plan to be there in 2009 if we can afford it. There is a map in the Brochure that illustrates where we will be this year in case you did not attend in 2007.

For many years we have been trying to figure out a way to attract more "public" to Cal-Stewart. We **desperately** need to recruit new people into our hobby. Every month we have to report more of our long-term Members are dying or becoming incapacitated and we need to attract new people to replace them. Because of the two-hall arrangement this year, we have come up with the following plan. The program this year will consist of two events: "The Wonderful World of Trains" and **The Cal-Stewart Train Meet**.

The "Wonderful World of Trains" (AKA Free Train Expo) will be held in the Brown Hall (Conference Center lower level) and is **free** to the public from 10 AM to 5 PM on Saturday and

from 10 AM to 4 PM on Sunday, (both days from 9 AM to 5 PM for Cal-Stewart Registrants-see below) November 22 & 23. The following events will happen here:

- Manufacturer's displays – Lionel, MTH, and Williams by Bachmann.
- Operating layouts – Standard Gauge, O gauge, S gauge, and HO gauge.
- Ralph Johnson Memorial Display – Historic Streamliner Displays of Toy Trains 1934-1941 along with Graphics, Movies and Railroadiana.
- Exciting Train Races & Demolition Derby – time trials on Saturday & competition on Sunday.
- Auctions on Saturday & Sunday starting at noon (sellers must be paid registered for Cal-Stewart, but anyone can buy).
- Special seminars: Marx Show & Tell at 11 AM on Saturday, and TCA Grading Standards at 11 AM on Sunday.
- Boy Scout Merit Badge Certification program on Saturday with live video transmission to [www.scouttrainorama.info](http://www.scouttrainorama.info)
- TTOS and TCA Club information tables.
- Promotional fliers from local train stores and train clubs.
- Special Public Only drawing for Lionel Polar Express Train Set and door prizes
- Overflow train sales from the White Hall (see below).

The **Cal-Stewart Train Meet** requires regular Cal-Stewart registration and a badge (\$30 per family – includes spouse and children under 21 years of age) and will be held in the White Hall (East Pavilion) from 9:AM to 5:PM on Saturday and Sunday, November 22 & 23. The following events will happen here:

- Over 350 tables of collectable trains and parts.
- No table limit for sellers (tables are \$35 each).
- Ability to sell in the Saturday and Sunday auctions (held in the Brown Hall-lower level starting at 1 PM Saturday and 12 Noon Sunday).
- Saturday Night Auction
- Giant Sunday Drawing
- Some Manufacturer product displays and for sale.
- Ability to attend the **John King Welcoming Dinner Party** (Friday November 21 from 6:30PM-10PM) at the Pasadena Masonic Temple, 200 South Euclid, Pasadena (Corner of Euclid & Cordova, across and down the street from the Cal-Stewart Meet. Includes a complete buffet dinner with coffee and dessert plus cash bar, and a silent auction of Cal-Stewart Souvenir Car Prototypes and collectables.

Because of the two-day "Wonderful World of Trains" exhibit in the Brown Hall and the prospect of lots of "public", many of the train stores in the greater LA area have allowed us to put fliers in their stores, and this free advertising will greatly help with attendance of the "public". Stores participating include: **The Train Shack** in Burbank, **Allied Model Trains** in Culver City, **Milepost 38 Model Trains** in Lakewood, **The Train Stop** in San Dimas, **The Hobby Warehouse** in Lakewood, **The Original Whistle Stop** in Pasadena, **The Toy Train Shop** in Anaheim, **Trains Are Good** in San Diego, **Ventura Hobbies** in Ventura, **San Diego Model Railroad Museum** in San Diego, and **Arnie's Train Store** in Westminster (sorry if I missed anyone). In addition, we will have a color ad in **The Pasadena Weekly**. Also, there will be a Sesame Street event in the nearby Pasadena Civic Auditorium, and signage and handouts have been prepared to direct these attendees to our "Wonderful World of Trains" event.

**For 2008, there will be no \$10 "public" admission to the White Hall on Sunday**, as has been the case in recent years. The Meet costs us well over \$20,000 to put on, and we have to recover these expenses by requiring a \$30 registration fee (no late fees this year) to attend the White Hall. When you consider that in 2007, a couple with children would have paid \$20 on Sunday only to attend as "public", the \$30 fee to attend on both Saturday and Sunday is a much better deal. **See you at Cal-Stewart 2008!**

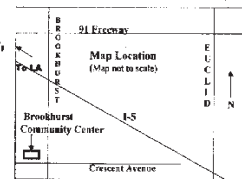

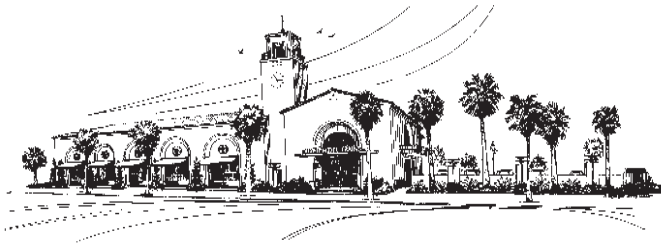

## New TTOS Grading Standards

At the August 14, 2008 board meeting, the Board of Directors of the Toy Train Operating Society decided to return to our previous grading standards by TTOS members when offering trains for sale or trade. Effective immediately, please start using these grading standards:

**MINT** - Brand new, absolutely unmarred, all original and unused.

**LIKE NEW (LN)** - Free of any blemishes, nicks or scratches, original condition throughout, very little sign of use.

**EXCELLENT (EX)** - Minute nicks or scratches, no dents or rust.

**VERY GOOD (VG)** - Few scratches, exceptionally clean, no dents or rust.

**GOOD (GD)** - Scratches, small dents, dirty.

**FAIR** - Well-scratched, chipped, dented, rusted, or warped.

**POOR** - Beat up, junk condition, some usable parts.

All description standards are mainly in regard to condition of finish. This should be kept constantly in mind. In all categories except Mint or Like New, parts can and may be missing. Any such missing parts must be noted when describing the piece. Also, any replacement parts must be noted, or exceptions to the stated category. All restored or refinished items are to be so stated. Note that the standards apply to original items. No grade above Excellent can apply to a refinished piece. We do not here recognize in-between or multiple grades, such as Excellent plus, Excellent minus or Very Good to Excellent.

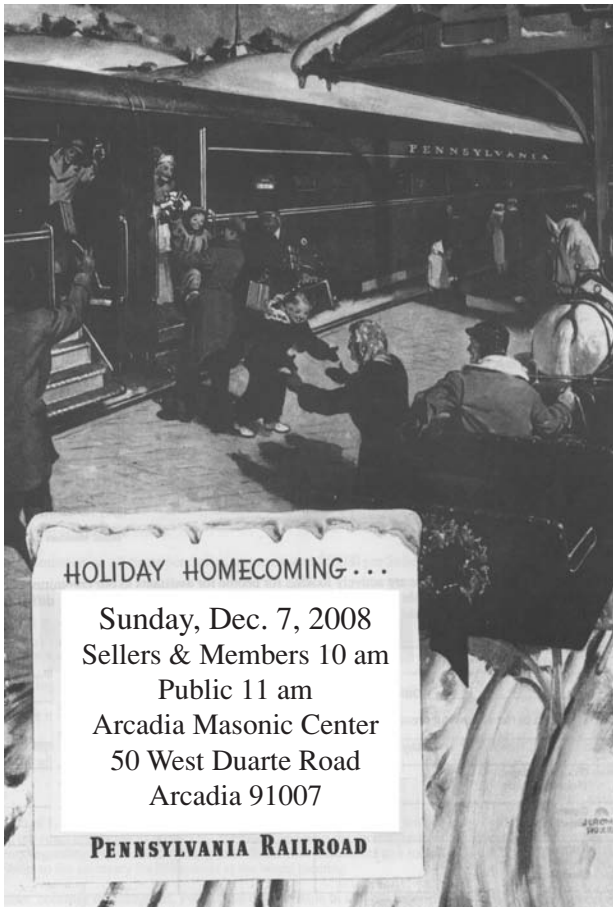
